A hiring freeze was just announced by Gov. Kaine, most likely accompanied by larger budget cuts. More details will become available after Feb 21. Cuts in CALS will not be across the board, but will be strategic based on cluster and strategic plan priorities. Faculty positions will be protected as will high priority Extension areas and our undergraduate and graduate teaching programs. No early retirements or buy-outs will be offered.

We have been very successful as faculty over the last six years with extramural funding doubling, 600 more undergraduates, and a doubling of graduate students. We are all doing our jobs well and our funding is still being cut by the state. She is committed to working with faculty to preserve the progress that has been made.
