CALS Course Globalization Grants Request for Proposals, FY 2021 9 November 2020

CALS faculty are invited to submit proposals to revise existing courses to create international engagement opportunities, provide intercultural learning and cross-cultural competency resources, or assist students in awareness and engagement in global issues, topics, trends, and perspectives.

Guidelines:

- Open to CALS teaching faculty.
- Proposals should focus on enhancing existing relationships (such as with exchange or faculty-led study abroad partners, research collaborators, strategic partners, etc.) or developing new relationships with a high likelihood of impact and success.
- Proposals, current course syllabus, and detailed budget should be sent to martinn@vt.edu no later than COB 30 June 2021.
- Your proposal should include the following information (no more than two pages, please): 1) course number, name, and semester the course will be offered, 2) the non-VT partner faculty/organizations, 3) detail of revisions to the existing course and how the revisions will enhance global education and support course learning outcomes, 4) how the new learning outcomes will be sustained in future course offerings, and 5) anticipated benefits to students.

Evaluation:

- Proposals will be evaluated by CALS Global and CALS Academic Programs and other reviewers as necessary.
- Proposals will be ranked on 1) evidence of lasting impact of internationalization on undergraduate education, 2) probability of success and sustainability, and 3) potential benefits for CALS students.

Please note that this call is open to CALS faculty in long-term positions. We do not anticipate funding requests of more than \$2,500. This call will remain open until June 30, 2021 or until available funding is exhausted, whichever comes first.
